Welcome Message from the SCP President

Dear SCP Family,

Welcome to the Society of Counseling Psychology (SCP) program for the 2022 American Psychological Association Convention in Minneapolis, Minnesota!! FINALLY, we are reunited and it feels so good.

As I reflect on my Presidential year with Division 17, I am so grateful to lead alongside so many amazing leaders, including students and professionals at various career levels. This year has been challenging as we have faced racism, white supremacy, transphobia, homophobia, heterosexism, cisgenderism, sexism, ableism, and the interlocking oppressions that harm those of us with intersectional identities. We are in the midst of a mental health crisis and educational settings and teachers are under attack. Yet, I have seen many in Counseling Psychology dig deeper and use the values and tools of our profession to disrupt, advocate, and act to create transformational change and keep us moving towards social justice, liberation, and healing.

My presidential theme this year has been "Transforming Counseling Psychology through Critical Consciousness and Radical Change." It is time for us to think critically and act radically if we hope to change the world. Given the current level of harm and the immense need for structural and institutional change, transformation is our only option. Our work with our consultants, Jernigan and Associates has provided invaluable and challenging feedback and input to help us address the ways anti-Black racism shows up in our association and how whiteness is embedded in our structures, practices, and policies. We have engaged in deep discussions about how to center justice and advocacy in SCP. These important dialogues and conversations will be taking place in a variety of ways through our APA sponsored programs and the amazing schedule in our Liberation Lounge.

Our convention program has been curated to highlight this focus on transformation and justice and we hope you will find this first in-person convention in three years to be energizing, thought-provoking, meaningful, and engaging.

Monica Johnson and Lauren Harper** for creating an amazing schedule of important meetings and events as well as innovative and liberatory programs this year.
