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Our project:



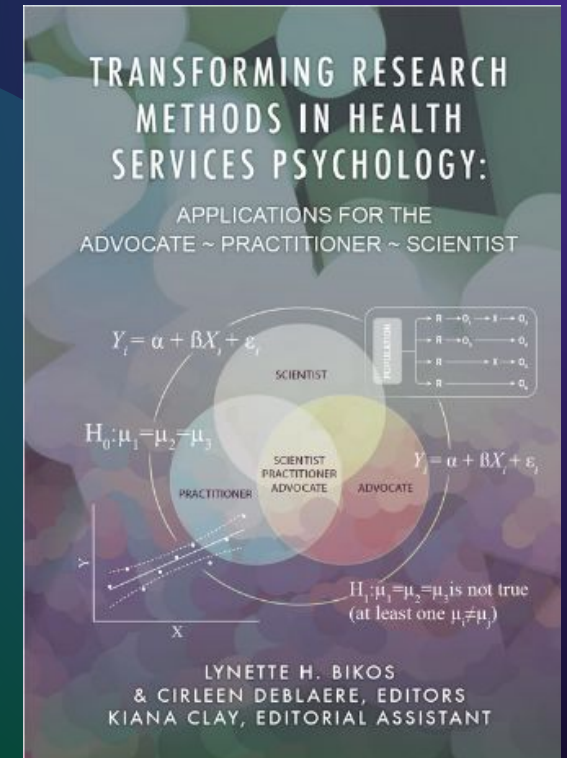
- An Open Education Resource (OER) that would provide a socially responsive “textbook” for teaching research methods in health services psychology

 - Identities that have been marginalized in higher ed and psychology
- Openly peer-reviewed with a focus on *formative* feedback
